

# Uniform Dress Code Policy 2010-2011

The dress code is designed to create an appropriate academic climate. FCTHS believes that standards of neatness and appropriateness in clothing encourage an atmosphere conducive to learning, work and discipline. Furthermore, it is felt that pride in one's school and oneself is, in part, influenced by appearance.

## General Policies

- Students must comply with the "Uniform Dress Code Policy" during school hours.
- Students should be clean and neat in appearance at all times.
- When students are released from the cafeteria at 7:20 all outer garments are to be put in their locker. They are not to be removed until 2:20 at the end of 5<sup>th</sup> period. Outer garments include coats, scarves, headgear, hair nets, gloves and sunglasses, and telecommunication devices.

## Uniform Dress Code Policy 2010-2011

Item	Information
<b>Miscellaneous</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ear piercings are the only ones allowed</li> <li>• ALL necklaces must be tucked inside of shirts</li> <li>• Any jewelry or item that could be used as a weapon or displays drug, alcohol, or violent information is prohibited</li> <li>• Head or hair covering s are prohibited</li> </ul>
<b>Hair</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Extreme hairstyles that are attention getting or distract the learning environment will not be permitted</li> </ul>
<b>Tattoos</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Offensive, obscene, or distracting tattoos may not be visible.</li> </ul>
<b>Field Trip Apparel</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students must be in dress code while engaged in school field trips</li> <li>• The principal may approve other attire in advance</li> </ul>
<b>Maternity Dress</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Same requirements as other students, including tucked shirts</li> <li>• If you need alternative dress code, consider enrollment into the TAPP program</li> </ul>

\*Attire must fit naturally and may not be oversized or tight fitting. \*Any item or dress code issue not referenced is **prohibited!**

\*Dress attire may be worn on game days and business dress days with permission from the principal.

\*Principal/Assistant Principal discretion may be used in determining disposition.

**Progressive Discipline Resolution Matrix:** Dress code violations accumulate throughout the entire school year. This does not reset at the beginning of each trimester.

Offense	Resolution
1 <sup>st</sup>	One day of detention
2 <sup>nd</sup>	Two days of detention
3 <sup>rd</sup>	One day of ISAP
4 <sup>th</sup>	Two days of ISAP; Parent notification of suspension on next offense
5 <sup>th</sup>	One day suspended
6 <sup>th</sup>	Two days suspended
7 <sup>th</sup> and above	Student sent home until parent conference completed
